APPLICATION FOR A NATIONAL INSURANCE NUMBER

Your application for a United Kingdom (UK) National Insurance (NI) number

You need a National Insurance number if you:

- are working in the UK
- are self-employed
- claim benefit or Tax Credits in the UK
- are a partner of a person who has claimed benefit or Tax Credits
- are applying for a loan from the Student Loan Company

The information you give in your application will be used by both the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) and HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC). The way in which they use that information will depend mainly on the reason for your business with them. DWP allocates the NI number and HMRC keeps the record of all the NI contributions you pay and any credits you earn. Many UK benefits are based on NI contributions. By the 'United Kingdom' we mean England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

DWP and HMRC may get information from others to check the information you give and improve their services. They may also give information to other organisations as the law allows, for example to protect against crime.
